NOTE: All janitorial papers listed on the "Janitorial Paper Products Contract #83021" are approved. City & County of San Francisco staff may only purchase listed products when the product category is designated as "mandatory." (SF Environment Code Chapt. 2). The Department of the Environment monitors sales reports by City vendors.

Vendors/manufacturers: Products are added to this list only when solicited by the City & County of San Francisco. Solicitations will be posted on the Dept. of the Environment web site.

Definitions

Mandatory Within a "mandatory" product category, San Francisco City staff may purchase *only* listed products. To purchase other products, a waiver from the Office of Contract Administration will be required beginning 10/1/07.

Currently on SF Contract? Products marked in this column are currently offered on a San Francisco citywide term contract.

Criteria Used for Review [SFJP](#) San Francisco Janitorial Papers Criteria, 6/1/07: All products in the Janitorial Paper Products Contract meet environmental and health criteria established by the San Francisco Dept. of the Environment. The EPA's Comprehensive Procurement Guidelines were used to establish the minimum level of recycled content. Paper towels and tissues only: Whitening technologies may not use chlorine or chlorine derivatives.

Exceptions to Mandatory Purchasing Requirements The mandatory requirement does not apply for these specific product uses.

Paper towels Exceptions to purchasing from this list are those City departments that require specific paper for proprietary paper towel dispensers. We strongly encourage City departments to purchase universal paper towel dispensers when possible.
